## 1. PLEDGE MONEY

- Any students with per lap pledges will get their pledge sheets back the next day so they can collect any money still due. These are due back no later than Feb 4<sup>th</sup>.
- Attached is the pledge form along with an envelope to be used when collecting pledges.

## 2. INDIVIDUAL PRIZES

- Collecting \$10 or more earns student a Free Dress pass.
- Collecting \$40 or more earns a Free Dress pass and a Sacred Heart School 2019 Jog-A-Thon shirt that students are able to wear on Spirit Days!!!
- **Collecting \$100 or more will allow student to be entered into a drawing to win an iPad!**
- Student that raises the most donations will receive a \$50 gift card of their choice.
- Medals and \$10 gift cards are awarded for most laps ran by boys and girls in each class.

## 3. CLASS PRIZES

- Pizza parties for classes that collect the most money and that runs most laps.

## 4. VOLUNTEERS

- We are in need of volunteers on the day of the event to set up, count laps, supervise children and show support!
