## **Sacred Heart School Faith Formation Book Club**

As part of your journey and growth in the Catholic Faith, we welcome you to the **Sacred Heart School Faith Formation Book Club.** This year we are offering an online Book Club, for Sacred Heart School families only, that will allow members that join to discuss Catholic literature, deepen their Faith, and strengthen their relationship with God and with our fellow Sacred Heart family.

If you have students who are receiving Sacraments (Reconciliation, First Holy Communion, or Confirmation), families will need to complete 5 hours of Faith Formation per year (not per student). 2 ½ hours must be completed before Reconciliation, and the remaining 2 ½ hours must be completed before your child may receive First Holy Communion. As a way to complete hours, families may read Catholic literature and then discuss the books online. The books currently being reviewed are The Four Signs of a Dynamic Catholic: How Engaging 1% of Catholics Could Change the World and Rediscover Catholicism, both by Matthew Kelly.

Parents may also complete Faith Formation hours in a variety of ways through the Church. Please check the Parish bulletin or the Parish Office for more information. **Faith Formation hours must be completed by March 11, 2019.** 

In order to become a member of the Sacred Heart Faith Formation Online Book Club, you will need to follow the directions below.

- 1. First, you will need access to the internet.
- 2. You will then need to email a request to join the book club to <a href="mailto:kararuelas@gmail.com">kararuelas@gmail.com</a>. You will receive a reply back within 36 hours that will provide you with an invite link to join SHS Book Club.
- 3. The link will then take you to the website goodreads.com
- 4. If you are not already a member of Goodreads, you will need to click the sign-up button located in the upper right-hand corner of your page. At this point you will have 3 options to sign-in via 1) Facebook,
  2) Amazon, or 3) Your personal email. If you are already a member of Goodreads, just sign in.
- 5. You can choose to find friends in order to get book recommendations, or you can skip this step.
- 6. You will enter the Sacred Heart Book Club home page.
- 7. Click on the "Goodreads" logo to enter the main page; here you will also be able to add and save your favorite genres to allow Good Reads to make recommendations.
- 8. Using the tabs at the top, you can add your own books, browse recommendations, and use the community tab to return to the Sacred Heart group.
