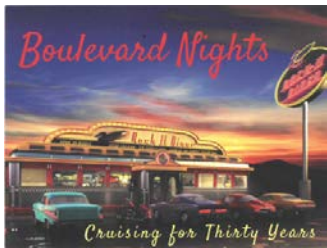

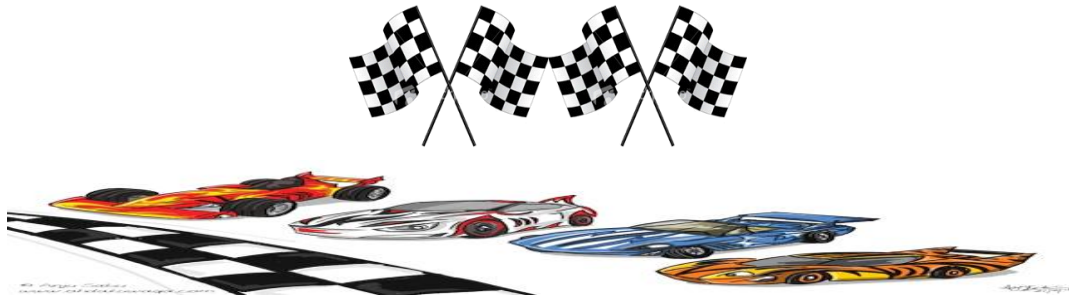

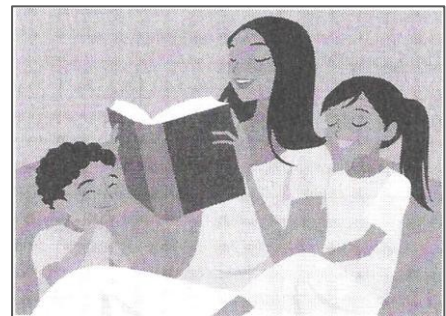
LITERARY CHARACTER DAY

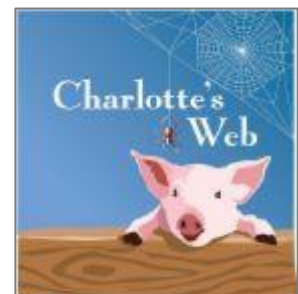
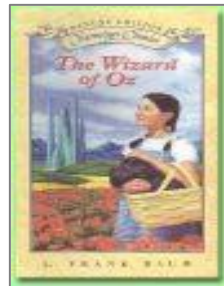
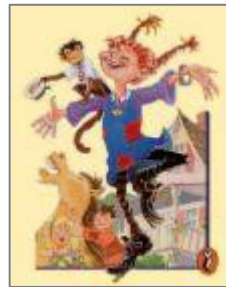
