## Reminders

1. If your child stays for nap, please make sure to put their name on their blanket and pillow. If there is a special toy or stuffed animal that your child likes to have for nap, they may bring one **(with their name on it)**, otherwise please do not bring toys from home. 2. Please make sure you check cubbies and files every day in case children have projects or notes to take home.
3. When bringing your child to school, PLEASE make sure that you use the cross walk for safety as well as a way to model good habits for your children. We have had a few close calls.
4. Please remember there is NO PARKING ALLOWED in front of the yellow gates at any time. Make sure that you close and latch all gates behind you when you enter or exit the school.
5. Remember to bring your children in on time unless something comes up. If something does come up please call ahead and let us know. **Breakfast is at 8:45!** Any children who are brought in at 9 or later will miss breakfast.
