Student guidelines for technology use during Digital Learning:

- Students are asked to utilize the Google Classroom platform for academic purposes only. Comments made on the Classroom stream should be for academics or in response to something the teacher has asked of the class.
- We also ask that students do not create Google Chats or Meets outside of the teachers scheduled Meets utilizing their school email. We cannot guarantee supervision on student created Meets.
- Students should also not be in Google Meets when the teacher is not present. This creates a liability issue for us when there is no adult supervision on these Meets.
- Students should log on to their Meet no sooner than 5 minutes prior to the scheduled time.
- We are constantly working on responsible digital practices to keep our students safe.
- Student Expectations for Google Meets:
 - o Students should be sitting upright and attentive to the presenter/teacher.
 - o Students microphones should be muted unless the presenter/teacher asks them to do otherwise.
 - o Show the same respect and kindness you would at school for each other and for your teacher.
