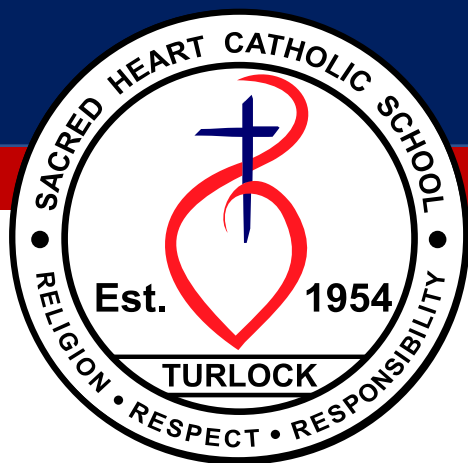

A message from our principal...

Greetings Sacred Heart School Families and Welcome to the 2021-2022 school year!

We hope this edition of the Heartbeat finds you healthy and well rested from a wonderful summer. Please review this HB in its entirety as there is a lot of information included here. Covid-19 protocols: Many of our C19 protocols have shifted a bit with the June 15th opening of the state. We are still mandated to wear masks indoors but all students and staff are permitted to unmasked outdoors at all times. We will continue to practice many of our mitigating strategies, hand washing, sending home sick students immediately, quarantining classes or students when needed, sanitizing desks, air purifiers in every room, etc. Our teachers are well versed in all C19 protocols and will follow the directives of our diocese and parish leaders.

First day of school: Our first day of school is Wednesday, August 11th. On this day, all students (K-8) will begin school at 8:00am. We will not utilize the Cooper Avenue drive through on this morning. We will hold our traditional first day of school blessing on the steps of the school. Please join us at 8:00am for a short ceremony and celebration of our students and staff. **Our school day will end at 11:45 am for grades K-2, 12:00 pm for grades 3-5 and 12:15 pm for grades 6-8th.** We will utilize the drive through pick up method for dismissal on our first day of school. Standard Uniform

BOYS: white, navy, or gray polo with navy blue uniform quality shorts or pants. **GIRLS:** white, navy, or gray polo with Dennis Uniform jumper (K-2nd) or skirt/skort (2nd-8th) and/ or navy uniform quality shorts or pants.

“Mass Attire” Uniform

For Friday mass, our school community is required to wear “mass attire”. “Mass attire” will also be worn for some field trips, masses at neighboring parishes or any other event we feel warrants a more formal dress. **BOYS:** White collared shirts, long or short sleeves. Long slacks, gray or navy blue (gray slacks must be Dennis Uniform to keep the shade of gray standard). Dennis Uniform plaid tie, there are different versions, clip on or knot. No sweatshirts are permitted, only sweater vests or sweaters (however sweater vests and sweaters are not mandatory). Shoes need to meet the general requirements of our adopted uniform policy. Boys may change into shorts after mass if they wish. **GIRLS:** Plaid jumpers, skirts or skorts, depending on the grade level. White collared shirts, long or short sleeves. Girls may wear the Dennis Uniform plaid tie, there are different versions, clip on or knot. No sweatshirts are permitted, only sweater vests or sweaters (however sweater vests and sweaters are not mandatory). Shoes need to meet the general requirements of our adopted uniform policy.
